THURSDAY Jr. SAILING RACES, AWARDS AND SCORING

Each week YCSH Sailors are invited to participate in the Thursday Jr. Sailing Series. These seven Thursdays provide an opportunity to race against fellow YCSH youth sailors and gain experience in local waters. Six of the Thursday Races will provide opportunities for instruction and be open only to YCSH Members. One of the Thursday Races (July 15th) will be open to all YCSH members and other sailors in the South Jersey Summer Series as it is the YCSH Jr. Invitational Regatta. Scores of all YCSH sailors will be recorded throughout the seven-week Thursday Jr. Sailing Series and will be combined for cumulative prizes and awards. First place sailors in each fleet, and all Green Fleet Sailors, will be recognized each week. At the Sailor's Brunch, on Aug 15th, series and perpetual awards, including the Edelmayer and Betty Church awards, will be given to sailors who participated in at least 60% of the races run for each category of the Thursday Jr. Sailing Series. The scores for the Thursday Jr. Sailing cumulative and perpetual awards will be calculated solely from the pool of sailors who met the 60% requirement.

**First place sailors are recognized each week. Awards will be given at the Sailor's Brunch, August 15, 2010, for the first, second, and third place winners for the overall season. To be eligible for a trophy at the end of the summer you must participate in 60% of the races run for each fleet
